

Dr. Tsong is a board-certified ophthalmologist and eye surgeon. Originally from New Jersey, Dr. Tsong first studied Chemical Engineering at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology where he graduated in the top 5% of his class (Phi Beta Kappa). After a brief period of time working at Exxon, he had a change of heart and enrolled in Harvard Medical School. At Harvard, he was inspired by the field of ophthalmology. He realized that, as an eye physician, he could do something very meaningful - to help others by treating and curing blindness.

His subsequent postgraduate studies took him around the country. This included an internship at The Mount Sinai Hospital in New York City and residency training at The George Washington University Medical Center in Washington, DC. He then moved to Los Angeles where he completed a fellowship in Medical Retina at USC's world-renown Doheny Eye Institute. Dr. Tsong is board-certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology. He is an active member of the American Academy of Ophthalmology and the American Society of Retina Specialists.

During his medical career, Dr. Tsong has participated in numerous research studies and has published his findings in leading medical journals.

He has co-authored a book chapter focusing on wet AMD (in Age-related Macular Degeneration, 2nd Edition. 2007).

Since joining Greenwich Ophthalmology Associates, Dr. Tsong has focused on helping the local population take care of their eyes. He works full-time in Greenwich and is available for same-day and evening appointments. He cares for all types of eye problems including glasses, cataracts, and glaucoma. In addition, he specializes in retinal problems such as vitreous floaters, retinal tears, diabetic eye disease, and AMD. Dr. Tsong's family is originally from Taiwan and he speaks Mandarin Chinese.
